Evidence and Impact Research Grants (EIRGs) Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I find details of the Evidence and Impact Research Grants?

The EIRG call documentation can be downloaded from The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System (https://in-tendhost.co.uk/edinburghuni/). In order to download these documents and to submit your application you will be required to register on this system (by giving your name, email address and a phone number).

If you have any specific questions relating to your application these can be asked through The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System. A direct reply will be sent to the email address provided upon registration.

Will there be updates made to the call for Evidence and Impact Research Grants?

If any details are uploaded onto The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System for clarification, after the call is launched, each person who has registered on the system will be sent an email to the address they provided to notify them of any updates.

Will this Frequently Asked Question document be updated while the EIRG call is open?

No, any necessary clarifications will be uploaded to The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System and registered users of this system will be notified of these through email alerts.

Can the ESPA Directorate comment on our draft EIRG proposal?

The Directorate cannot routinely provide feedback on EIRG proposals. However, if you are unclear on certain aspects of the call requirements and whether your work/submission will meet all of these, then you should direct your query through The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System. Queries should be concise (no more than 1 page A4) and concerned with the points that require clarification. The Directorate is unable to provide comprehensive feedback other than stating whether it meets the priorities of the current call. The Directorate cannot comment on the likelihood of funding success.

What are the deadlines for the call?

The deadline for electronic submission of EIRG proposals is **16:00 GMT (UTC)** on **7**th **October 2011.**

What will The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System be used for?

This system will only be used as a mechanism to submit applications. All other correspondence, relating to the next stages of the process, will be made directly to the email addresses provided when registering on the The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System.

Will applicants have to register with Je-S to submit applications for EIRGs?

No, all submissions should be made through The University of Edinburgh Online Procurement System (https://in-tendhost.co.uk/edinburghuni/).
